









Current State Workflow in Primary Care

- What is the wait time?




Current State eReferral in Primary Care

How do we get there?

The problem:

- For primary care: Not all specialists/clinics on Ocean so have 2 workflows
- For specialists: Not enough primary care providers use eReferral so not worth changing



The Solution - eFax:


- Allows primary care to utilize eReferral for more patients and gain the benefits of it
- Increased spread of eReferral usage among primary care as a result
- More specialists sign on for eReferral due to usage by primary care and gain the benefits of it as well
